*So Now What Do I Do Now?*

**Colossians 4:2-6**

2 Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving. 3 At the same time, pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ, on account of which I am in prison – 4 that I may make it clear, which is how I ought to speak.

5 Conduct yourselves wisely toward outsiders, making the best use of the time. 6 Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt so that you may know how you ought to answer each person.

What does Paul's choice tell us about what our faith should be rooted in?

How does it compare with how you understand your faith?

How can focusing on these two areas help you keep Christ central in your life?

In what ways do you think your life would change if you focused on these two practices?
