Discussion Questions

What are some events that are just absolutely impossible? Have you ever seen something that you thought should be impossible actually happen?

So far in this letter, Jude has told the readers that there is strife, division and lostness plaguing the church, that people in the church are denying the Lordship of Jesus, that the faithful must continue to grow in their faith in the midst of this, and they must help others be rescued from error and judgment. If you were in that church, what would you think after reading this?

What picture of God does it put in your mind and heart?

How is God able to “present you blameless before the presence of His glory”?
What about Jude adding “with great joy”?

According to Jude, why can we trust that God is able to do this and will do it?
